

# **Preservation of Affordable Housing in Communities of Need**



15 units will be designated as permanent supportive housing with on-site case management and counseling.

We have purchased and restored

## 114

units of affordable housing.

We identify units in neighborhoods where we can maximize impact:

66 units are in neighborhoods

- health and economic loss.<sup>1</sup>
- 48 are in areas with minimal access to healthy, whole foods.

64 are in neighborhoods with low economic mobility and high inequality.<sup>2</sup>

**Protect Affordable Housing and Tenants from Dilapidation** 

#### 37 Roofs Repaired/Replaced

- Peace of mind for future renters/homebuyers
- Adds value to homes with average roof renovation valued at \$7,500

#### 78 HVAC Repaired/Replaced

- 1 hour of A/C reduces heatrelated illness by 20%<sup>3</sup>
- 6 homes had insulation added saving about 10% on energy costs<sup>4</sup>

#### 9 Homes Made Lead-Safe

- Every \$1 on lead-safe work provides \$17 in social benefits<sup>5</sup>
- \$256,000 in lead-safe work so far


